FRA. San Pablo de Buceite 2025 is open to all artists, in all disciplines of contemporary art, whether individuals or groups.

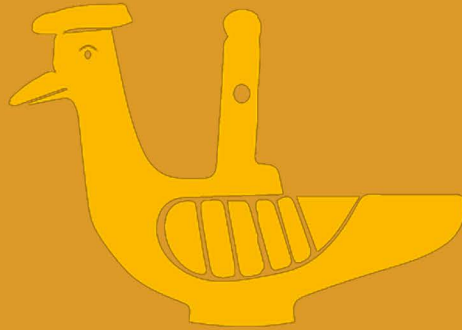
Those wishing to participate must submit an artistic project to be developed during the event, which will run from **September 15 to 19, 2025**.

The theme is open to all.

The Town Council will cover the costs of food, accommodation, subsistence, and transportation for the artists whose projects are selected, and the artists will leave their works as a legacy in the town. The organization will also provide the materials and infrastructure necessary for the execution of each project.

The selected artists will produce their work in San Pablo de Buceite, where it will be permanently exhibited.

The organization and the City Council will be responsible for the location of each work, depending on the discipline to be performed and the preferences and needs of each artist.



RULES FOR PARTICIPATION

FIRST. Call for Entries

The Jimena de la Frontera City Council and the San Pablo de Buceite District Municipal Board are opening a call for entries to participate in the

FRA. San Pablo de Buceite 2025,

International Festival of Contemporary Art, and proposes the use of public and private spaces in the urban center of San Pablo de Buceite for artistic recreation.

Art in any of its disciplines. The aim is for the project and the work to generate a dialogue between art, society, and the environment.

SECOND. Recipients.

All creators and artistic collectives over 18 years of age are welcome to participate.

THIRD. Production.

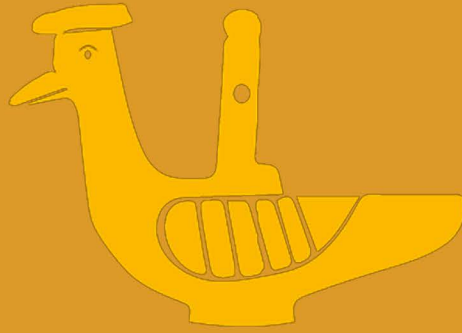

FIFTH. Budget.

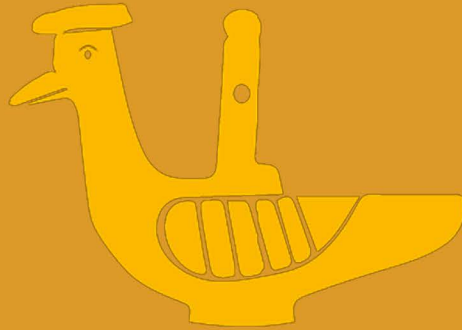
Each selected project will receive a daily allowance of 100 euros for the duration of the project's execution and completion. This amount will be distributed at the conclusion of the art event.

The aforementioned amount includes taxes and is subject to income tax withholding.

The Jimena de la Frontera City Council will cover the artists' travel expenses, following the guidelines established by the festival organizers (bus, train, plane, personal vehicle).

It will also cover the costs of materials for the execution of the submitted artistic proposal. Accommodations will be provided at a local hotel.

As many projects as the festival's budget allows will be approved, taking into account travel expenses, materials, and the feasibility of each project.



SIXTH. Participation.

Artists wishing to participate in the call for proposals must submit an application in person or by email to alcaldiadejimena@gmail.com, along with their project, **before July 25, 2025** (the deadline for submitting applications).

This application must be submitted in A4 format, in a Word or PDF format, and must include:

- Title / Discipline.

Descriptive report. Explanation and description of the proposal with images, plans, sketches, and whatever else the artist deems necessary.

- Technique / Production.

The proposal must be accompanied by the technical requirements for the development of the work, a list of necessary materials, and a travel budget for those coming from outside the municipality.

- Portfolio.

A brief resume, photo of the artist, email, contact phone number, website/blog/social media (optional).

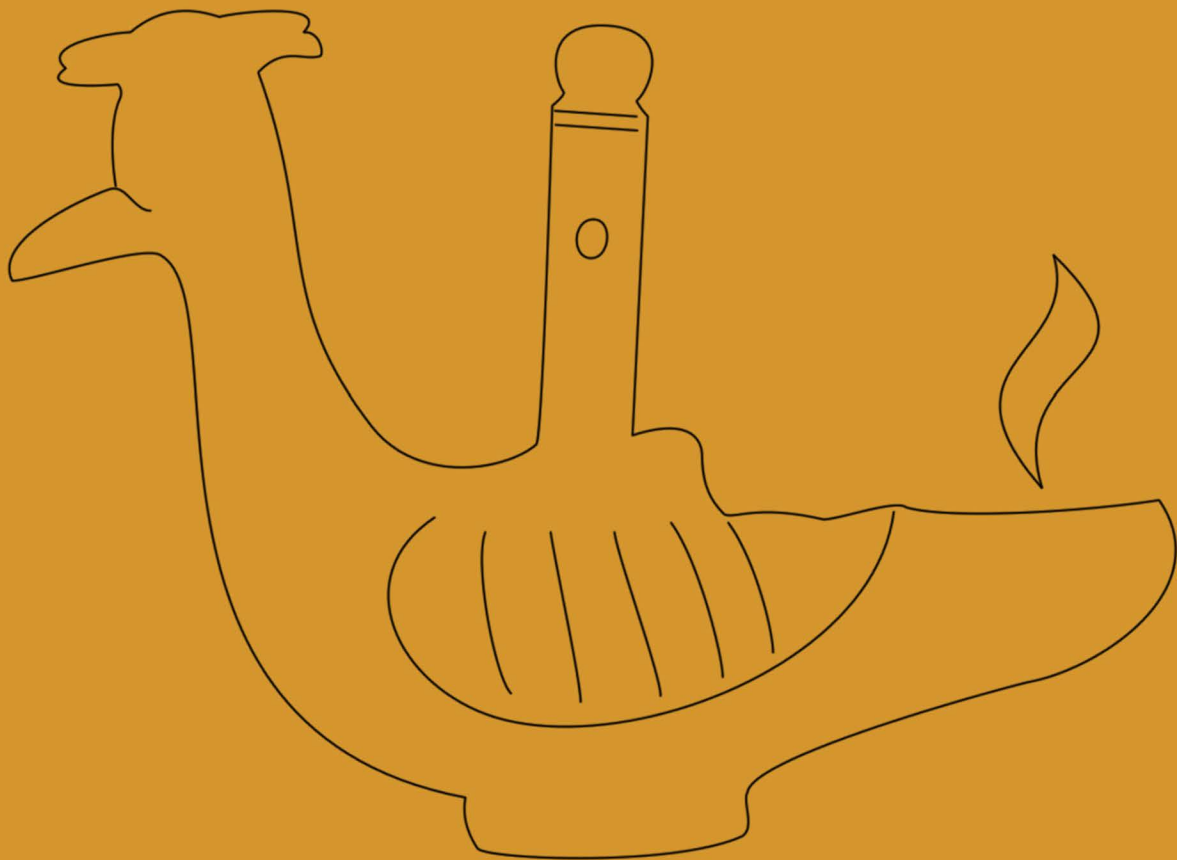
Selected projects will be notified by email or phone within 5 days of the application deadline.



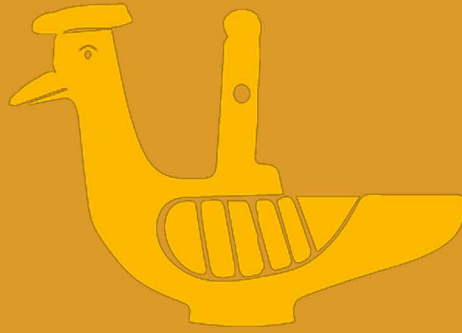
